Stories and Stuff about the Quarry

The Snowdonia Slate Trail project is providing an opportunity for year 6 pupils to take responsibility for a special evening to be held at the school when adults will be invited to drop in with their 'stuff and stories' i.e. photos, items and anecdotes, about life during the golden age of the quarries. The purpose is to gather material so that it can be put into a phone app which will accompany walkers of the trail as they walk through the slate quarrying villages of Snowdonia, which includes **Rachub a Llanllechid**. Year 6 pupils will host the evening by:
